



New Beaver Borough DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, COVID-19 has been declared by the World Health Organization and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention a "public health emergency of international concern" and a "pandemic"; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has declared a state of emergency due to the identification of COVID-19 infected citizens; and

WHEREAS, Council Members intend to protect the residents of New Beaver Borough, Lawrence County, through this Declaration; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of a significant event which would seriously affect the health, safety, and welfare of a substantial number of Borough citizens or preclude the operation or use of public facilities and services;

WHEREAS, New Beaver Borough Council and the Mayor declared a Disaster Emergency on March 20, 2020;

WHEREAS, New Beaver Borough Council and Mayor extended said declaration for the safety and welfare of the citizens of New Beaver Borough on March 27, 2020 for an additional 30 days;

WHEREAS, New Beaver Borough Council and Mayor would like to again extend said declaration for the safety and welfare of the citizens of New Beaver Borough until the next regular meeting of Council on May 11, 2020;

WHEREAS, New Beaver Borough Council and Mayor would like to again extend said declaration for the safety and welfare of the citizens of New Beaver Borough until the next regular meeting of Council on June 8, 2020;

WHEREAS, New Beaver Borough Council and Mayor would like to again extend said declaration for the safety and welfare of the citizens of New Beaver Borough until the next regular meeting of Council on July 13, 2020;

WHEREAS, New Beaver Borough Council and Mayor would like to again extend said declaration for the safety and welfare of the citizens of New Beaver Borough until August 31, 2020;

WHEREAS, New Beaver Borough Council and Mayor would like to again extend said declaration for the safety and welfare of the citizens of New Beaver Borough until October 31, 2020;

WHEREAS, New Beaver Borough Council and Mayor would like to again extend said declaration for the safety and welfare of the citizens of New Beaver Borough until November 30, 2020;



WHEREAS, New Beaver Borough Council and Mayor would like to again extend said declaration for the safety and welfare of the citizens of New Beaver Borough until January 11, 2021;

NOW THEREFORE, on behalf of the Council Members of New Beaver Borough, Lawrence County, and pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501(b) of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S.A. 7101 et seq., I hereby declare the existence of a public health local disaster emergency in New Beaver Borough, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania.


FURTHER, Borough Departments may, in conjunction with the Borough Emergency Management Coordinator, suspend such regulatory requirements deemed necessary to respond to disaster emergency and to conduct Borough business.


FURTHER, the Borough of New Beaver Emergency Management Coordinator is directed to coordinate the activities of the emergency response in coordination with other emergency management officials and take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this public health local disaster emergency.

FURTHER, this Declaration of Disaster Emergency is hereby extended until January 11, 2021. This Proclamation shall take place effective immediately.


